The travelling art space NOMAD presents photographer Martin Möll (Switzerland) in Rome

NOMAD is a series of contemporary art exhibitions that take place in unusual and alternating private or public spaces. NOMAD explores the conditions and possibilities of site specific artwork and aims to open new perspectives on the work of the artists involved, as well as on the chosen sites.

For its Rome intervention, NOMAD has invited the emerging Swiss photographer Martin Möll to present his work in an openair off-space situated between the walls of the Istituto Svizzero di Roma and the church of San Isidoro, close to Piazza Barberini. With “corpus delicti” Martin Möll invites us to enter the intriguing and mysterious universe he encountered during his residency at the Cité des Arts in Paris last year.

After this temporary appearance in Rome, NOMAD will go on to host exhibitions in Paris, Zurich and Berne. NOMAD is an artistic project of Swiss artist Alain Jenzer.
